

2010 AMBI Clinical Ethics Conference – November 19, 2010

This year the Alden March Bioethics Institute of Albany Medical College will be hosting its first Clinical Ethics Conference on Friday, November 19, 2010. The 2010 AMBI Clinical Ethics Conference is a conference in which keynote speakers, guest faculty and conference participants gather at the Alden March Bioethics Institute for a full day of engaging discussions and breakout sessions revolving around a single theme. This year's theme explores the new Family Health Care Decisions Act and its impact at the hospitalized patient's bedside.

This is an idea that is evolving and also an opportunity to impact the community. The target audience for this conference includes: institutional ethics committee members, physicians, nurse practitioners, physician assistants, nurses, pharmacists, social workers, chaplains, hospice staff, case managers, lawyers, healthcare facility administrators, and others interested in healthcare decision making.

The conference schedule is crafted to help area healthcare providers and ethics committee members better understand the 2010 New York Family Health Decisions Act that went into effect on June 1, 2010.
